The Oregon Symphony Association assumes no responsibility for lost, misdirected, late, non-delivered, or other failed efforts to submit a timely ticket order. All ticket orders must be received and fully paid prior to the drawing date in order to be valid. The IRS does not consider the purchase of a raffle ticket to be a tax-deductible charitable contribution. All sales are final.

### **WINNING THE PRIZE**

The Oregon Symphony Association will make reasonable efforts to contact the persons named on a winning raffle ticket order form, using only the information on the winning raffle ticket order form.
